In this pānui, we look forward to your feedback, especially regarding the Post Settlement Governance Entity (PSGE). You previously emphasised the need for a single whare for all in Waikaremoana, and we value that perspective! While the PSGE has a role in receiving crown assets, the hapū and marae ultimately hold the mana in this area. Another critical theme in our discussions with you was accountability and security, ensuring your aspirations take precedence.

Last week, your negotiation team met with Tühoe and our lawyer to address the technical aspects of the PSGE.

Like you, they recognise the necessity of having one whare for everyone in Waikaremoana. They also agree that having two entities could lead to unnecessary competition and an unfair system, which we want to avoid. A Waikaremoana whare belongs to everyone, and achieving this goal is vital. First, we must cultivate strong relationships with ourselves and one another. Through these connections, we reach a consensus, ensuring fairness for all in the whānau.
